





ASPECTOS RELEVANTES EN EL DESARROLLO DE LA ACTIVIDAD	<p>La Conferencia Internacional "Las Condiciones Cambiantes y los Cambios de Enfoque de la Profesión Académica" se realizó en Berlín, Alemania, entre otras cosas, porque la idea de la universidad moderna que hoy conocemos proviene de los ideales de Humboldt tras la creación de la Universidad de Berlín en 1810. En esa institución se vieron materializados sus ideales de la unión de la enseñanza-investigación, la libertad e independencia académica así como la creación de la comunidad de profesores y estudiantes.</p> <p>Asistieron al evento más de 200 académicos, administradores e investigadores del área de Educación Superior. Prominente figuras como Ulrich Teichler (Alemania), Philip Altbach (USA), John Brennan (UK), Georg Krücken (Alemania), John Meyer (USA), Guy Neave (Holanda), Simon Schwartzman (Brasil), Jung Cheol Shin (Corea), Jussi Välimaa (Finlandia), entre otros, participaron como plenaristas.</p> <p>La premisa central del evento fue que el nuevo contexto donde se desarrolla la profesión académica está cambiado a pasos agigantados. La implementación de nuevas tecnologías; la internacionalización de las Instituciones de Educación Superior; las reformas que muchos sistemas educativos están ejecutando a nivel mundial; el papel que juega la academia en la actual sociedad del conocimiento; la masificación de la Educación Superior y sus consecuencias; los nuevos sistemas de evaluación que están surgiendo; el creciente llamado a la profesionalización del trabajo académico; los cambios en la gobernabilidad institucional; los mecanismos de aseguramiento de la calidad; el balance que se busca entre la enseñanza y la investigación a nivel superior; entre otros, fueron algunos de los temas debatidos en este contexto.</p>

<b>OBTENIDOS</b> (Contacto con futuros expositores, becas, firma de convenio, etc.)	<p>La participación en dicha Conferencia Internacional permitió aprender de la experiencia de los proyectos que fueron presentados, a fin de que en un futuro Panamá pueda participar en actividades de investigación similares para conocer los cambios en condiciones que esta sufriendo la profesión académica de nuestro país y compararla desde una perspectiva internacional. De igual forma, durante el desarrollo del evento se logró establecer contacto con representantes de universidades amigas tanto de América como de Europa, lo que en un futuro pudiera facilitar comunicación para el establecimiento de programas de cooperación conjuntos en tema de interés para la UTP. Como resultado directo de esta comunicación y red de contacto, se invitó a la UTP a participar de la Segunda Reunión Regional MesoAmérica del Proyecto INFOACES (Sistema Integral de Información sobre las Instituciones de Educación Superior de América Latina para el Área Común de Educación Superior con Europa), a celebrarse en Ciudad de Panamá el 21 y 22 de junio de 2012. Con esta invitación se espera acordar la participación de la UTP como institución adscrita al proyecto.</p>
<b>CONCLUSIONES</b>	<p>Estudiar las percepciones, condiciones y opiniones de los que se encuentran actualmente trabajando en la academia resulta necesario para buscar los mecanismos que permitan a este grupo adecuarse y repositionarse a los múltiples cambios que la Educación Superior y su contexto está experimentando.</p>




